3) DISCUSS BACKING – WHY DO BACKING ACCIDENTS HAPPEN?

4) DISCUSS HOW TO PREVENT

- Activate horn and flashes
- G.O.A.L. Get Out and Look
- Back only if needed
- Check mirrors before and during backing
- Survey the Area repeatedly
- Back no further than needed
- Stay Alert
- Back as soon as arrive at destination
- Back slowly

5) DISCUSS PRE-TRIP INSPECTION OF VEHICLE

- Look and leakage of coolants, fuel and lubricants
- Check exterior of vehicle tires, all lights, doors, glass body damage and mirrors
- Check horn, windshield wipers, steering, defrosters and fuel
- Check brake action. Know hand brake adjustment
- Make test stop before leaving yard
- Given the second second

6) DISCUSS ENGINE, CLUTCH AND TRANSMISSION

- □ Start engine and use seat belt when vehicle is in motion
- Clutch In-park brake one
- Use cutch properly
- □ Shift proper gear sequence
- Refrain from excessive RPM's

7) DISCUSS BRAKING

- Plan ahead to minimize braking
- □ Stop smoothly

8) DISCUSS STEERING

- Steer smoothly, minimum adjustment
- Have proper driving posture, grip on wheel
- Stay centered in lane of travel

9) DISCUSS LIGHTS

- Dim headlights for on-coming traffic
- Adjust speed to headlight spray
- Use four-ways when required

10) DISCUSS STOPPING OR STOPPED

- Check to rear when slowing. Warn following traffic
- In neutral, park brake on at stoplight
- Use space cushion to avoid sudden stop
- Stop behind stop line or cross-walk
- □ Stop before crossing sidewalk
- Leave one vehicle length in front
- Count one-two-three at start up

11)PARKING

- Avoid hitting curbs
- Park close to curb
- Lowest forward gear-park brake applied
- Look over shoulder when pulling out
- Park off pavement on highways
- Turn wheels on hills
- Leave space in front

12) DISCUSS CLOSE QUARTERS MANEUVERING

- Maneuver vehicle through serpentine obstacle
- Maneuver vehicle through offset alley obstacle
- Maneuvers backing

13) DISCUSS BACKING

- Avoid all unnecessary backing
- Back first, if necessary
- Check rear immediately before backing
- Sound horn
- Look back as well as check mirrors
- Back to the operator's side
- Recheck conditions on long back when necessary
- Control speed

14) DISCUSS TURNING

- Signal intention well in advance
- Get in proper lane well in advance
- Check traffic and turn when way is clear
- Addination lane on turns
- Turn at safe speed
- Use turn signal when changing lanes
- Turn into proper lane
- Check mirrors before turn
- Find safe path well ahead
- Avoid shifting on turns
- Avoid U-Turns

15) DISCUSS TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SIGNALS

- Handle stale green lights correctly
- Heed all traffic signs
- Establish space cushion
- Come to full stop at stop signs
- Apply "right turn on red" correctly

16) DISCUSS INTERSECTIONS

- Approach prepared to stop
- Check left, right, left
- □ Yield right-of-way at all times
- Check mirrors
- Stay alert to rural intersections
- A Make certain other drivers see them

17) DISCUSS RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING

- Approach prepared to stop
- Select proper gear before crossing
- Cross at safe speed
- Clear crossing in advance

18) DISCUSS PASSING

- Avoid passing in unsafe location
- Signal lane change well in advance
- Avoid tail gating waiting chance to pass
- Check mirrors
- Use ground viewing habit

19) DISCUSS HILLS

- Use proper gear ascending or descending
- Stop and restart without rolling back
- Test brakes before descending long hills

20) DISCUSS SPEED

- Maintain speed consistent with ability and conditions
- Adjust speed to vary road, weather, traffic conditions and legal limits
- Reduce speed before entering curves
- Scan steering wheels

21) DISCUSS COURTESY AND SAFETY

- □ Yield right-of-way at all times
- Avoid crowding and other drivers
- **G** Keep to right
- Use horn properly
- Use path of least resistance

22) DISCUSS GENERAL DRIVING ABILITY AND HABITS

- Remain alert and attentive
- Adjust speed of changing conditions
- Safely perform routine functions inside of vehicle
- Have self-confidence in handling of vehicle
- Even-tempered with others
- Force eyes into the future
- Minimum 8-second mirror checks
